### **Processing Purposes and Legal Basis:**

We process personal data for the purpose of debt purchase in accordance with Article 6 (1) lit. f GDPR. Our legitimate interests consist (i) in the acquisition of debt purchase portfolios, (ii) the collection of our receivables by ourselves or by third parties commissioned by us.

Personal data is also processed for the purpose of compliance with legal and regulatory obligations applicable, e.g. applicable tax legislation, money laundering and fraud prevention, in accordance with Article 6 (1) lit. c GDPR.

### **Data Categories and Data Sources:**

We process the following categories of data: Master data, contact data, contract data, receivables data, payment information. Data under those categories was transmitted to us by the original creditor or one of the recipients named below.

### **Recipients:**

In the course of our activities, we have and/or will disclose personal data to the following categories of recipients as appropriate: debt buyers, credit service providers, service providers, third party debtors, courts, bailiffs, lawyers, debt management companies.

### **Duration of Storage:**

After three years from the full payment of the outstanding claim or the termination of the collection procedure, we will check whether there is a legal obligation to further retain your data, or part of it, otherwise we will delete it..

### **Rights of data subjects:**

Provided the legal requirements are met, you have the following rights under Articles 15 to 22 of the GDPR: the right to information, access, rectification, erasure, restriction of processing, and data portability.

In addition, pursuant to Article 21 of the GDPR, you have the right to object to processing where it is based on our legitimate interest or that of a third party, Article 6(2) of the GDPR. 1 f of the GDPR.

Finally, according to Article 77 of the GDPR, you also have the right to lodge a complaint with a competent Data Protection Supervisory Authority, including the Authority located in your place of residence.
